#### News from your APA President

We've all heard the phrase: "Life turns on a dime." Well, recently I have personally experienced such an event. A small group of us were riding motorcycles back from Seattle, Washington, to San Antonio. On the seventh day of a planned ten day ride, as we were riding through the Navaho Nation in Arizona, one of my friends, Kenny, hit a cow. Livestock roam openly through the area and we were, in hindsight, traveling too fast for the conditions.

Kenny's bike hit the cow, killing it, and he was very lucky to have survived. He was airlifted to Flagstaff, where they performed surgery to repair his torn aorta. Getting him from the middle of the Navaho Nation to the Level One trauma center in Flagstaff took four and a half hours. During this time the blood clotted in his aorta and his organs below his heart were all damaged, including his spine. Kenny, as of today (Oct. 17), remains in critical condition, on a ventilator and with numerous other life threatening conditions. It's a fact that when Kenny recovers, he will be in a wheelchair. Maybe for the rest of his life; nobody knows at this time.

What I do professionally - being a RAS and ADA Specialist - does not usually directly affect me, other than providing an income. But it will from now on, because Kenny, who is one of my closest friends, will be a wheelchair user. So now it's personal. And so I want to sincerely thank all of you for the work that you do. We do make a difference, and it matters to millions of people out there the work that we do, and that we do it thoroughly and professionally. Kenny has a very long road ahead of him, but to the best of my ability, I want to make sure that the built environment will not be any more of an obstacle than absolutely necessary.

Fortunately, I was on a much smaller bike and a much slower speed. I, and to my knowledge the dog, both survived without serious injury. My prayers are with his friend for a full recovery. Any one of us can experience a life altering issue at any time that could leave us with some type of disability. I have a niece that has been deaf since birth and am amazed at what she can do and what she has done with her life including getting a masters' degree. Yet, I still see the challenges she faces as a deaf person. What we do today as Registered Accessibility Specialists will help ensure access for not only those with disabilities today, but those that will have disabilities in the future.

Peter and I have been working with the legal team since last December to amend the rules and procedures that impact our business. We have recently had the opportunity to review and comment on an early draft of the new proposed rules and procedures that TDLR shared with us. By the time of publishing this newsletter, we will have attended the advisory board meeting in Austin on November the 7th where the new proposed rules and procedures will be discussed prior to publication in the Texas Register. #### Jim Boyce Memorial Scholarship Applications Now Available for Students

The Jim Boyce Memorial Scholarship was established by the Accessibility Professionals Association (APA), to honor and recognize our friend and colleague Jim Boyce. Jim was formerly a Plan Review Manager with the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR) and was one of the drafters of the Texas Accessibility Standards (TAS), in 1994. When Jim retired from TDLR, he became a Registered Accessibility Specialist (RAS) and was among the Charter Members of APA. The success of APA is in large part due to Jim's leadership in its earlier years. Due to the nature of this memorial the scholarship is only available to college students in Texas.

NOTE: Interested parties looking to hire a Specialist, will NOT be able to find you unless you have updated all your "interests".


